THE SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM (SFSP) IS ALSO COVERED UNDER THE U.S DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND ADMINISTERED BY THE ODE. THIS PROGRAM PROVIDES FREE, NUTRITIOUS MEALS TO HELP CHILDREN IN LOW-INCOME AREAS GET THE NUTRITION THEY NEED TO LEARN, PLAY AND GROW THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER
