CANSTRUCTION® Cleveland *Annual Event Calls Attention to Hunger*

Strongsville, OH -On Thursday evening April 12, 2018 at South Park Mall, 14 local architect teams will design and build structures made entirely of full cans of food. The structures will all follow the theme, “Can Your Imagination Run Wild?” At the end of the exhibit, the cans will be donated to the Greater Cleveland Food Bank. Through combined Canstruction Cleveland and Canstruction Jr efforts, over 35,000 pounds of food and an additional check for \$4,000.00 was donated from the event last year. The structures will be on display at Southpark Mall through April 22.

The completed structures will be judged on Friday, April 13, 2018 and awards will be presented at the reception Saturday, April 14 at 6 pm for various categories. Last year, awards were presented to the following teams:
